Therefore, students’ educational records, academic work, and responses to instructional strategies are subject to inquiry and research, and findings may be published. In every inquiry, the information will be available only to the investigators and authorized administrators (unless release is compelled by legal proceedings), and will be reported in such a way that subjects cannot be identified, either directly or indirectly. Permission for your child to take part in educational research activities excludes the *Other Research* described in the next paragraph.

Other Research – UNO Early College High School will occasionally participate in other research activities, such as studies of children’s physical, social, or emotional development. For studies of this sort, the researcher is required to obtain the written informed consent of at least one parent, as well as the informed assent of the minor child. For this type of study, the parent(s) will receive a written explanation of the purpose of the study, as well as a detailed explanation of the procedures to be used, and will be asked for written permission for their child(ren) to participate. Parent and child are entirely free to decide whether or not to participate in such studies, and no penalty is incurred if either chooses not to participate.
